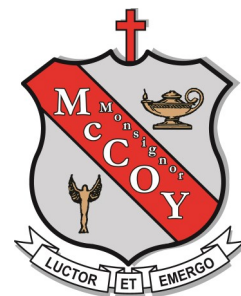

First Day - Tuesday, September 4, 2018:

Grade 10

- ⇒ The 2018-2019 School Year begins on Tuesday, September 4, 2018 at **8:30 AM**.
- ⇒ The first day will be a full day with dismissal at 2:40 PM.
- ⇒ Busses will run as per Southland schedule – check the Southland website for further details at www.southland.ca
- ⇒ Registration Procedures will be posted at the entrance of the school.

Grades 11 & 12

- ⇒ The 2018-2019 School Year begins on Tuesday, September 4, 2018 at **10:30 AM**.
- ⇒ The first day will be a modified day with dismissal at 2:40 PM.
- ⇒ **Grade 11-12 busses will run two hours later than usual for that morning only**
- ⇒ Registration Procedures will be posted at the entrance of the school.

**Students are to bring paper, pens, and pencils as these will be required on the first day.
Class supply lists will be available on the first day of classes from all teachers.**

2018 - 2019 Timetables:

To facilitate timetable changes please fill in the attached **Request for Timetable Change** sheet and scan and e-mail it to our counselor, Mr. Hendricks at doug.hendricks@mhcbe.ab.ca. He will e-mail you with confirmation. Alternatively drop it off at the school office on or after August 22, 2018.

- ⇒ The Counselor will be seeing students for timetable changes (by appointment only) on the following dates: **Monday, August 27, Tuesday, August 28 and Wednesday, August 29.**
- ⇒ **Students/Parents wishing to make timetable changes are asked to email as indicated above, drop off the attached 'Request for Timetable Change' form included in your summer package or come to the school on Friday, August 24 and sign up for a 20 minute appt.**
- ⇒ **Monsignor McCoy counselors and administration reserve the right to schedule students according to the student and master timetable needs, and to ensure a balance of classes.**
- ⇒ Timetable changes will not be made for teacher selection or being with a friend in class.
- ⇒ Timetable changes must be made through our counselor Mr. Hendricks.
- ⇒ If you have received this letter without a timetable, please come to the school on Friday, August 24 to fill out a registration form, and schedule an appointment with a counselor for a timetable.
- ⇒ If you have received this package, and no longer plan to attend Monsignor McCoy, please contact us ASAP at 403-527-8161.
- ⇒ **The Monsignor McCoy office will be open beginning Wednesday, August 22.**

Textbooks/Lockers/Locks:

Students in all grades will pick up their textbooks during regularly scheduled classes.

Grades 10-12 students will be issued lockers - **Grade 10 students will receive new locks (Grades 11 & 12 students must use previously issued school locks).**

Fees:
