Besides working hard at your studies to obtain your high school diploma, there are many graduation items that you must start addressing (if you have already not done so)

Graduation Checklist

- Be sure you have met all grad requirements as per page 3 (attached)
- If you have any questions or concerns please see Mrs. Melle or Mrs. Laing immediately!
- 1st tentative grad list is posted at the beginning of March after semester one marks are received. This grad list will be updated regularly.
- Final grad list will be posted April 22, 2021, after midterm marks are available.
- Students maintain their status on the grad list as long as they:
 - 1. have not failed any courses that would take them below the expected 100 credits.
 - 2. have successfully completed the required CTS modules in which they are enrolled.
 - 3. have Religion 15, 25 and 35 successfully completed must be passing Religion classes in semester 2 by the Midterm Report Card.
 - 4. have school fees paid in full

Mass and Ceremony will be dependent and based on AHS guidelines at time of the event.

- Mass at 3:30 pm (gown only no cap) on Thursday, May 20, 2021 at the Holy Family Parish -
- Reserved seating for the graduating class (grad class is to sit together)
- Ceremony 7:00pm (cap and gown) at the Cypress Centre

Banquet and Dance will be dependent and based on AHS guidelines at time of the event.

 Information on banquet cost, ticket purchase dates and deadlines, ticket purchase links, method of payment, per person allowances and total number allowances for indoor functions will be based on AHS guidelines at time of event and will be sent out at a later date

Attend Grad Meetings

- Be listening for announcements and check the grad bulletin board (located outside the main office) for committee meeting dates and times
- Volunteering for committees is essential for grad success

Cap and Gown Purchase (mandatory)

- Purchase form is included in this package
- Forms must be filled in and returned to Mrs. Pancoast in the front office on or by or before February 22, 2021
- The \$85.00 graduation fee (included on your school fee invoice) must be paid before ordering your grad gown
- Once we receive the gowns, students will be notified for pick-up at the school.





Grad Photos

- Individual pictures will be taken at SC Photo with appointments starting on February 15th. Please book on-line at scphoto.ca with your student ID as your password.
- All grads must have their photo taken for the yearbook and composite picture
- Yearbook sitting (2 picture maximum) is done at no cost
- Full graduation sitting has a cost of \$20.00 per sitting
- Ordering grad photos is optional and at your expense
- Boys are to wear a white shirt and a black or dark tie for photos, and girls should wear a white v-cut shirt or tank top

- Students are to hand in or email their forms to the office or Mr. Shemko at Thomas.shemko@mhcbe.ab.ca by March 26, 2021 (No Exceptions)

- Gold cords will be presented to students with grade 12 Honor Roll standing as described in the Student Handbook pg.7
- The Valedictorian will be the student with the highest academic standing as described in the Student Handbook pg. 8

Requirements for High School Diploma

Please check off the categories that you will complete or have completed. High School Diploma Requirements – Alberta Education Requirements

- □ English 30-1 or 30-2
- □ Social 30-1 or 30-2
- □ Grade 11 Math (Any 20 or 20-3 level course)
- □ Grade 11 Science (Any 20 or 24 level course)
- CALM
- □ Phys Ed 10
- □ 10 Credits in Options (any combination of options will meet the requirements: CTS, Fine Arts, Second Language, Phys Ed 20 or 30)
- □ 10 Credits in "30 Level" courses (grade 12 courses), in addition to English and Social
- □ Minimum of 100 credits in total

Requirements for Monsignor McCoy High School Graduation

Requirements for Students attempting to achieve a High School Diploma:

A Monsignor McCoy graduation ceremony is a celebration of the students successfully completing the requirements below. If these requirements are not met by April 22, 2021 you will not be put on the final grad list and therefore not be invited to attend.


- 90 earned credits by the end of Semester One to be on the first "grad" list
 - \Rightarrow K&E must have 70
- Potential for 100 passing credits by Midterm Report Card in Semester 2 credits for failing courses are not counted
 - \Rightarrow K&E must have 80
- Religion 15, 25 and 35 successfully completed must be passing Religion classes in Semester 2 by the Midterm Report Card. If you are registered in Religion 35 through Cyber School 1/2 of the course must be completed
- For Distance Learning or Cyber School courses you must have completed half of each course and must be passing
- Work Experience enrollment must be completed by Feb 26, 2021
- All school fees must be paid in full
- You must have completed a 20 level Social Studies and English and be enrolled in the 30 level of these subjects by the beginning of Semester 2
 - \Rightarrow K&E must have completed a 10 level and be enrolled in a 20 level
- If a student cannot obtain these requirements due to a diagnosed medical reason the administration of the school must be notified before April 22, 2021


