Grades 11 & 12

- ⇒ The first day will be a modified day with dismissal at 2:40 PM.
- ⇒ **Grade 11-12 busses will run two hours later than usual for that morning only**
- ⇒ Registration Procedures will be posted at the entrance of the school.

**Students are to bring paper, pens, and pencils as these will be required on the first day.
Class supply lists will be available on the first day of classes from all teachers.**

- ⇒ **Monsignor McCoy counselors and administration reserve the right to schedule students according to the student and master timetable needs, and to ensure a balance of classes.**
- ⇒ Timetable changes will not be made for teacher selection or being with a friend in class.
- ⇒ Timetable changes must be made through our counselor Mr. Hendricks.
- ⇒ If you have received this letter without a timetable, please come to the school between August 18 and August 27 to fill out a registration form, and schedule an appointment with a counselor for a timetable.
