Welcome to your Graduation year at Monsignor McCoy!!!

Besides working hard at your studies to obtain your high school diploma, there are many graduation items that you must start addressing (if you have already not done so).

Graduation Checklist

Be sure you have met all grad requirements as per page 4 (attached)

- If you have any questions or concerns please see Mr. Hendricks immediately!
- 1st tentative grad list is posted at the beginning of March immediately after semester one marks are received. This grad list will be updated weekly.
- Final grad list will be posted April 20, 2015, after midterm marks are available.
- Students maintain their status on the grad list as long as they:
 - 1. have not failed any courses that would take them below the expected 100 credits.
 - 2. have successfully completed the required CTS modules in which they are enrolled.
 - 3. Religion 15, 25 and 35 successfully completed must be passing Religion classes in semester 2 by the Midterm Report Card.
 - 4. School fees must be paid in full

Mass/Ceremony

- Mass at 3:30 pm (gown only no cap) on Thursday, May 14, 2015 at the Holy Family Parish
- Reserved seating for the graduating class (Grad class is to sit together)
- Ceremony at 7:00 pm (cap and gown) at the Cypress Centre

Banquet/Dance

- The format used for purchasing banquet tickets will be **ON-LINE** only this year!!!
- Banquet tickets will go on sale April 20, 2015 at 3:00 pm.
- Each Grad will be allowed a maximum of 6 tickets (1 Grad and 5 guests) and they will be \$37 each. The purchase of any additional tickets will be only authorized by Mrs. Lore Luca. Parents who indicate they would like additional tickets will be contacted, via email, if there are any extra tickets available to purchase on-line after all grads who have qualified for graduation have had access. You must have purchased the maximum of six tickets in order to request additional tickets..
- Mastercard, Visa and Debit will be accepted.
- Dance tickets will be available for purchase at the school. Dance tickets go on sale May 1 at a cost of \$10.00 each (cash or cheque only). Please contact Maria Bleile for these tickets.

Cap and Gown Rental (mandatory)

- Rental forms are included in this packet
- Forms must be filled in and returned to Ms. Bleile in the front office before February 27, 2015
- The \$75.00 graduation fee (included on your school fee invoice) must be paid before ordering your grad gown
- Once we receive the gowns, students will be notified for pick-up at the school.
- Grad gowns must be returned on Thursday evening after ceremonies (no exceptions)

Grad Rings (optional)

- Representatives from Richardson's Jewelry provide this service
- Brochures are available in the office
- Orders placed will arrive prior to graduation. A deposit may be required with order

Grad Photos

- Individual pictures will be taken at SC Photo February 9 14, 2015
- Sign up for appointments on line at www.scphoto.ca or the Monsignor McCoy website mccoy-highschool.ca and click the SC Photo link and then choose the Appointment tab. ID numbers are included in this grad package and must be used to book the appointment
- All grads must have a photo taken for the yearbook and composite picture
- This sitting has no cost
- Ordering grad photos is optional and at your expense
- Boys are to wear a white shirt and a black or dark tie for photos, and girls should wear a
 white v-cut shirt or tank top

Grad Write-Ups for Yearbook

- These will be completed in second semester (forms are included in this package)
- Students are to hand in their forms by April 1, 2015 (No Exceptions)

Grad Certificates and Awards

- All grads will receive an achievement certificate and a grad photo in a certificate holder
- Gold cords will be presented to students with grade 12 Honor Roll standing as described in the Student Handbook pg.8
- The Valedictorian will be the student with the highest academic standing as described in the Student Handbook pg. 8

Yearbook Pick Up

- 2015 McCoy yearbooks may be picked up around mid-October. Announcements with the exact dates will be posted on the McCoy web page and Newsletter
- Students with outstanding textbooks charges for missing/lost textbooks or outstanding school
 fees will not receive their yearbooks until all fees are paid in full

Requirements for Monsignor McCoy High School Graduation

Requirements for Students attempting to achieve a High School Diploma:

A Monsignor McCoy graduation ceremony is a celebration of the students successfully completing the requirements below. If these requirements are not met by April 20, 2015 you will not be put on the final grad list and therefore not be invited to attend.

- 90 earned credits by the end of Semester One to be on the first "grad" list
 - ⇒ K&E must have 70
- Potential for 100 passing credits by Midterm Report Card in Semester 2 credits for failing courses are not counted
 - ⇒ K&E must have 80
- Religion 15, 25 and 35 successfully completed must be passing Religion classes in Semester 2 by the Midterm Report Card. If you are registered in Religion 35 through Cyber School 1/2 of the course must be completed
- Registered in enough classes that total at least 30 credits for the grade 12 year
- CTS courses completed on schedule
- For Distance Learning or Cyber School courses you must have completed half of each course and must be passing
- Work Experience enrollment must be completed by Feb 27, 2015
- All school fees must be paid in full
- You must have completed a 20 level Social Studies and English and be enrolled in the 30 level of these subjects by the beginning of Semester 2
 - ⇒ K&E must have completed a 10 level and be enrolled in a 20 level
- If a student cannot obtain these requirements due to a diagnosed medical reason the administration of the school must be notified before April 20, 2015
- * Please note that participating in "Graduation Ceremonies" does not necessarily mean that a student will receive a high school diploma. Similarly, earning a high school diploma from Alberta Education does not necessarily mean that a student will be able to participate in "Graduation Ceremonies".



Monsignor McCoy Grad Banquet Ticket Sales Frequently Asked Questions

- InviteRight is a web application that allows you to purchase your grad banquet tickets securely online and allows you to pick the table you want to sit at. Check out this link for a demo of the process - http://youtu.be/p42k_EuHZds
- There will be a link on Monsignor McCoy Webpage that directs you to the InviteRight webpage prior to the sale date of April 20, 2015. Grad parents will be reminded through the Synervoice messaging system and your grad, when the date of ticket sales nears.
- Please do not log in until ticket sales are officially open! This shouldn't be an issue this year as there will be
 a countdown clock prohibiting sign in until the correct time. In the past, people have logged on early, filled
 in all the information, and waited to confirm the purchase of their tickets until the correct time, only to find
 that they can't purchase tickets! They have to refresh and log back in. Please do not actually log in with your
 graduates name and ID number until 3:00 pm on April 20th!
- When reserving your seats at the desired table, please put the graduates name on all the seats. Just copy and paste and it will go quicker!
- Visa/MasterCard/Debit payments only accepted online. No prepaid charge cards (M/C or Visa). If these payment options are not an option for you, please contact Lore Luca lore.luca@mhcbe.ab.ca.
- Each grad is only allowed to purchase 6 tickets total. This includes the ticket for the graduate. After the initial sales run from April 20th 26th, if there are any extra tickets available, you will be notified **IF** you chose this option on the website during your initial purchase. Please note, if you only purchase 4 tickets initially, you will not be given the option for extra tickets, so please know how many tickets you need when you initially log on. There is no discount for children's tickets.
- If there are any extra tickets, they will go on sale from April 28 to the 30th and you will be notified via email when the second round of sales will open. Dance tickets will also go on sale starting May 1st and are \$10.00 each.
- For those graduates with multiple families, please note that you can only log on once with their ID number (which is their student ID number from McCoy, e.g. 4501.... found on the label of their graduation package. Please do not lose this number you NEED it!) Because of this, you need to discuss how you will work this out before the initial sales date. Once you have logged in, you can only purchase a total of 6 tickets but they can be at different tables. They don't have to be together.
- If you need less than 6 tickets and buy the remainder for a friend (E.g. Dale only needs 4 tickets for his own graduation party but wants to buy the remaining 2 for his friend Jeff so Jeff can bring his grandparents...) make sure to buy the extra 2 for the friend at the friend's table right away. If you ask us to move them after the purchase, we can't guarantee that we'll be able to do it at that later date. So Grandma and grandpa might be sitting with a different grad at the banquet!
- Some students may not be eligible to purchase graduation tickets, for example, if your child has not made the FINAL GRAD LIST posted April 20, 2015 or has unpaid school/grad fees. Please contact the school if you require additional information.
- Banquet tickets will be printed and distributed, along with the invitation and graduation gown, to the graduate the week of graduation.
- Please keep in mind that we want everyone to have a great banquet and we want to accommodate all the requests that we can but sometimes that won't be possible.
- InviteRight demo will be held on Monday, April 13th at 7:00 pm in the Band Room.


