

# Welcome to your Graduation year at Monsignor McCoy!!! 

## Mass and Exercises - Thursday, May 14th Banquet and Dance - Friday, May 15th

Besides working hard at your studies to obtain your high school diploma, there are many graduation items that you must start addressing (if you have already not done so).

## Graduation Checklist

Be sure you have met all grad requirements as per page 3 (attached)

- If you have any questions or concerns please see Mrs. Melle or Mrs. Laing immediately!
- 1st tentative grad list is posted at the beginning of March after semester one marks are received. This grad list will be updated regularly.
- Final grad list will be posted April 22, 2020, after midterm marks are available.
- Students maintain their status on the grad list as long as they:

1. have not failed any courses that would take them below the expected 100 credits.
2. have successfully completed the required CTS modules in which they are enrolled.
3. have Religion 15,25 and 35 successfully completed - must be passing Religion classes in semester 2 by the Midterm Report Card.
4. have school fees paid in full

## Mass/Ceremony

- Mass at 3:30 pm (gown only - no cap) on Thursday, May 14, 2020 at the Holy Family Parish
- Reserved seating for the graduating class (grad class is to sit together)
- Ceremony at 7:00 pm (cap and gown) at the Cypress Centre


## Banquet/Dance

- The format used for purchasing banquet tickets will be ON-LINE only this year!!!
- Banquet tickets (includes entry into the dance) will go on sale April 24, 2020 at 3:00 pm.
- Each Grad will be allowed a maximum of 6 tickets ( 1 Grad and 5 guests) and they will be $\$ 45$ each. The purchase of any additional tickets will only be authorized by Ms. Diane MacDonald. Parents who indicate they would like additional tickets will be contacted, via email, if there are any extra tickets available to purchase on-line after all grads who have qualified for graduation have had access. You must have purchased the maximum of six tickets in order to request additional tickets.
- Mastercard, Visa and Debit will be accepted.
- Dance tickets will be available for purchase at the school office. Dance tickets go on sale May 1st at a cost of $\$ 10.00$ each (cash or cheque only). Please contact Maria Bleile for these tickets.


## Attend Grad Meetings

- Be listening for announcements and check the grad bulletin board (located outside the main office) for committee meeting dates and times
- Volunteering for committees is essential for grad success



Cap and Gown Rental (mandatory)

- Rental forms are included in this packet
- Forms must be filled in and returned to Ms. Bleile in the front office before February 28, 2020
- The $\$ 85.00$ graduation fee (included on your school fee invoice) must be paid before ordering your grad gown
- Once we receive the gowns, students will be notified for pick-up at the school.
- Grad gowns must be returned on Thursday evening after ceremonies (no exceptions)


## Grad Photos

- Individual pictures will be taken at SC Photo February 20-22 and February 27-29, 2020
- All grads must have their photo taken for the yearbook and composite picture
- Yearbook sitting (2 picture maximum) is done at no cost
- Full graduation sitting has a cost of \$20.00 per sitting
- Ordering grad photos is optional and at your expense
- Boys are to wear a white shirt and a black or dark tie for photos, and girls should wear a white v-cut shirt or tank top


## Grad Write-Ups for Yearbook

- These will be completed in second semester (forms are included in this package)
- Students are to hand in their forms by March 27, 2020 (No Exceptions)


## Grad Certificates and Awards

- All grads will receive an achievement certificate and a grad photo in a certificate holder
- Gold cords will be presented to students with grade 12 Honor Roll standing as described in the Student Handbook pg. 7
- The Valedictorian will be the student with the highest academic standing as described in the Student Handbook pg. 8


## Yearbook Pick Up

- 2020 McCoy yearbooks may be picked up around mid-October. Announcements with the exact dates will be posted on the McCoy web page and Newsletter

## Requirements for High School Diploma

High School Diploma Requirements - Alberta Education Requirements

- Social 30-1 or 30-2
$\square$ Grade 11 Math - ( Any 20 or 20-3 level course)
$\square$ Grade 11 Science - (Any 20 or 24 level course)
- CALM
- Phys Ed 10
- 10 Credits in Options (any combination of options will meet the requirements: CTS, Fine Arts, Second Language, Phys Ed 20 or 30)
- 10 Credits in "30 Level" courses (grade 12 courses), in addition to English and Social
- Minimum of 100 credits in total


## Requirements for Monsignor McCoy High School Graduation

Requirements for Students attempting to achieve a High School Diploma:
A Monsignor McCoy graduation ceremony is a celebration of the students successfully completing the requirements below. If these requirements are not met by April 22, 2020 you will not be put on the final grad list and therefore not be invited to attend.

- 90 earned credits by the end of Semester One to be on the first "grad" list
$\Rightarrow$ K\&E must have 70
- Potential for 100 passing credits by Midterm Report Card in Semester 2 - credits for failing courses are not counted
$\Rightarrow$ K\&E must have 80
- Religion 15,25 and 35 successfully completed - must be passing Religion classes in Semester 2 by the Midterm Report Card. If you are registered in Religion 35 through Cyber School 1/2 of the course must be completed
- For Distance Learning or Cyber School courses you must have completed half of each course and must be passing
- Work Experience enrollment must be completed by Feb 28, 2020
- All school fees must be paid in full
- You must have completed a 20 level Social Studies and English and be enrolled in the 30 level of these subjects by the beginning of Semester 2
$\Rightarrow$ K\&E must have completed a 10 level and be enrolled in a 20 level
- If a student cannot obtain these requirements due to a diagnosed medical reason the administration of the school must be notified before April 22, 2020
* Please note that participating in "Graduation Ceremonies" does not necessarily mean that a student will receive a high school diploma. Similarly, earning a high school diploma from Alberta Education does not necessarily mean that a student will be able to participate in "Graduation Ceremonies".


## Monsignor McCoy Grad Banquet Ticket Sales Frequently Asked Questions

- RightLabs is a web application that allows you to purchase your grad banquet tickets securely online and allows you to pick the table you want to sit at. Please be aware that you are only able to log into this system one time to purchase tickets. Check out this link for a demo of the process - http://youtu.be/p42k EuHZds
- There will be a link on Monsignor McCoy Webpage that directs you to the RightLabs webpage prior to the sale date of April 24. Grad parents will be reminded through the school messaging system and your grad, when the date of ticket sales nears.
- There is a countdown clock prohibiting sign in until the actual date and time of the sale. Please do not actually log in with your graduates name and ID number until 3:00 pm on April 24.
- When reserving your seats at the desired table, please put the graduates name on all the seats. This helps us to identify how many seats each grad has and where they are located. Just copy and paste the grads name into each seat assignment!
- Only Visa/MasterCard/Debit payments are accepted online. No prepaid charge cards work. If these payment options are not available to you, please contact Diane MacDonald - diane.macdonald@mhcbe.ab.ca.
- Each grad is only allowed to purchase 6 tickets total which includes a ticket for the grad and you can request up to 2 additional tickets. After the initial sales run from April 24th - 30th, if there are any extra tickets available, you will be notified IF you requested additional tickets during your initial purchase. Please note, if you only purchase 4 tickets initially, you will not be given the option for extra tickets, so please know how many tickets you need when you initially log on. Please note there is no discount for children's tickets.
- If there are any extra tickets, they will go on sale from May 1-4 and you will be notified via email when the second round of sales will open. Dance tickets will go on sale starting May 1st and are $\$ 10.00$ each.
- For those graduates with multiple families, please note that you can only log on once with the grad's ID number (which is their student ID number from McCoy, e.g. 4501.... - found on the label of their graduation package.
Please do not lose this number - you NEED it!) Because of this, you need to discuss how you will work this out before the initial sales date. Once you have logged in, you can only purchase a total of 6 tickets but they can be at different tables. They don't have to be together.
- If you need less than 6 tickets and buy the remainder for a friend (E.g. Dale only needs 3 tickets for his own graduation party but wants to buy the remaining 3 for his friend Jeff so Jeff can bring his grandparents...) make sure to buy the extra 3 for the friend at the friend's table right away and label the seats with your friends name. If you ask us to move them after the purchase, we can't guarantee that we'll be able to do it at that later date. So grandma and grandpa might be sitting with a different grad at the banquet!
- Some students may not be eligible to purchase graduation tickets, for example, if your child has not made the FINAL GRAD LIST posted April 22 due to not meeting the grad requirements or unpaid school/grad fees. Please contact the school if you require additional information.
- Banquet tickets will be printed and distributed, along with the invitation, to the graduate during the week of the grad banquet.
- Please keep in mind that we want everyone to have a great banquet and we try our best to accommodate all requests but sometimes that is not always possible.
